You have experience teaching a broad range of age groups and can create an inclusive, engaging and challenging learning environment where every child can develop confidence, teamwork, resilience and a lifelong appreciation of physical activity.

The International School Delft is an IB World School, offering the Primary Years Programme (IB PYP) in the Primary school, the Middle Years Programme (IB MYP) and Diploma Programme (IB DP) in the Secondary school.

- Teach PE lessons across the Primary School, from Early Years to Upper Primary.
- Deliver engaging and developmentally appropriate physical education programmes.
- Be responsible for the planning, delivery and assessment of the **PSPE (Personal, Social and Physical Education)** curriculum.
- Promote student wellbeing, physical development and healthy lifestyles.
- Teach in both the school's on-site facilities and the excellent sports facilities available through the **TU Delft** campus.
- Work collaboratively with classroom teachers and support staff to enhance student learning and wellbeing.
- Be supported by a PE Teaching Assistant on several teaching days.



We offer:

- A temporary cover position for **0.8 FTE (4 days per week)**.
- The opportunity to work in a truly international community of students, parents and colleagues.
- Access to excellent sports facilities both on-site and at TU Delft.
- Support from a PE Teaching Assistant on several days each week.
- Salary according to the Dutch Collective Labour Agreement for Primary Education (CAO PO).
